## **THE OMPHOY OCEAN RESORT A SNEAK PEAK**

### **OCEANFRONT ESCAPE**

The first oceanfront hotel development on Palm Beach in more than 18 years, The Omphoy Ocean Resort is scheduled to open in early 2009 and will be the only beachfront boutique hotel in Palm Beach.

Bringing the essence of the New York and South Beach boutique hotel experiences to a younger Palm Beach crowd, the clean, fresh and simplistic design at The Omphoy will combine obtuse angles and non-perfect shapes resulting in an experience perfect for the ultra-affluent CEO's, media moguls and socialites in town for the charity balls, holiday parties and fundraisers.

### **DESIGN**

Leslie Schlesinger, owner and interior designer, created a vision for The Omphoy centered on the luminescence and movement of water paired with modern Asian influences creating a hotel experience that will project a new level of balance. Infused with green, earth-friendly details evoking a relaxed and stress-free ambiance, The Omphoy will be a tranquil escape.

Upon entry, a grand staircase will beckon guests to the lobby of The Omphoy where floor-to-ceiling windows open the space to breathtaking views of the Atlantic Ocean. Giving the room a chic and solid vibe, the lobby bar top will consist of a 3.5-inch thick concrete slab top. Backlit cast glass instillation will create a sexy aura, while an Asian-influenced billiard table, 103-inch plasma television and sumptuous sofa seating will lend way to a genuinely inviting atmosphere.

### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

The Omphoy will boast 134 guestrooms and suites, all of which will offer panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean or the Intracoastal Waterway.

Each guestroom at The Omphoy will feature custom-designed furniture and beds that seem to float above the ground covered in crisp white sheeting.

Keeping consistent with the earthy design scheme, pure bronze tiles will cover the floors of all guestrooms and bathrooms, bringing elements of the earth to life.

**DECADENT DINING**

The Omphoy will feature surfside cuisine by celebrity chef Michelle Bernstein that will reflect the true essence of Palm Beach. Chef Bernstein, a 2008 James Beard Foundation award winner, was victorious over Bobby Flay on Food Network's "Iron Chef America" series and will bring her expertise to each dish at The Omphoy Ocean Resort.

**PALM BEACH SCENE**

A playground of the ultra-rich since Henry Flager founded the city in 1911, Palm Beach visitors both young and old stroll down iconic Royal Palm Way to its secluded shores, where mansions are cloaked behind curtains of cascading bougainvillea and the ocean is never more than a few steps away. A Mediterranean-style mecca, Palm Beach plays host to renowned cultural centers and society's most glittering balls and charity events.

Palm Beach is the perfect backdrop to showcase some of the region's most spectacular culture. Savvy shoppers who want to be on the cutting edge of fashion attend private trunk shows at Saks 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue or Neiman Marcus.
